## How it works

- Each team pays a tax-deductible entry fee of \$200.
- Each team is made up of **four adults**. Any business (large or small!), school, civic group, club or neighborhood may sponsor a team.
- Teams work together to spell words, so there is **NO SOLO SPELLING**.
- Teams compete in rounds, with the winner of each round joining in a final Championship "Spell-Off."
- We encourage uniforms, costumes, team spirit, and friendly competition. A Best Costume Award will be given to the team with the most creative costumes, and a Spirit Trophy will be awarded to the school team supported by the most enthusiastic audience cheerleaders. Spirit contestants will strut their stuff in an outrageous Spirit Parade!
- Trophies will be awarded to the winning team.
