How it works

- Each team pays a tax-deductible entry fee of \$200
- Each team is made up of four adults. Any business (large or small!), civic group, club or neighborhood organization may sponsor a team.
- Teams work together to spell words, so there is NO SOLO SPELLING.
- Study guides are sent to contestants upon receipt of check. Most of the contest words will be taken from this list.
- Teams compete in rounds, with the winner of each round joining in a final Championship "Spell-Off."
- We encourage uniforms, costumes, team spirit, friendly competition! A "Spirit Trophy" will be awarded to the school team supported by the most enthusiastic, creative and colorful audience cheerleaders! Spirit contestants will strut their stuff in an outrageous Spirit Parade!
- Prizes will be awarded to the winning team and refreshments will be served to all.
